## Trends in the Percentages of High School Graduates Assessed at College-Level English and Math by Nine Local High Schools: Fall 2000 to Fall 2008

This page shows the trends in the percentages of local and all recent high school graduates assessed at college-level English and math at Chabot since 2000. The percentages assessed at college-level English and math were stable between 2000 to 2005, but dropped between 2006 and 2008. The percentage of local high school graduates assessed at college-level English went from 23 percent in 2000 to 27 percent in 2005 and decreased to 15 percent by 2008. The percentage of local high school graduates assessed at college-level math went from 24 percent in 2000 to 26 percent in 2005 and decreased to 20 percent by 2008.

There has been a similar trend in the assessment data for all high school graduates. The percentage of all high school graduates assessed at college-level English went from 24 percent in 2000 to 25 percent in 2005 and decreased to 15 percent by 2008. The percentage of all high school graduates assessed at college-level math went from 23 percent in 2000 to 22 percent in 2005 and decreased to 19 percent by 2008.




