

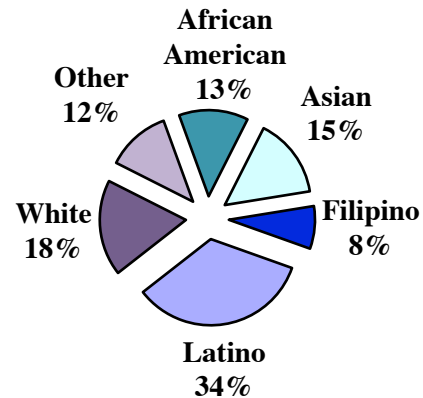

Diverse, First Generation Students Starting at Basic Skills Levels

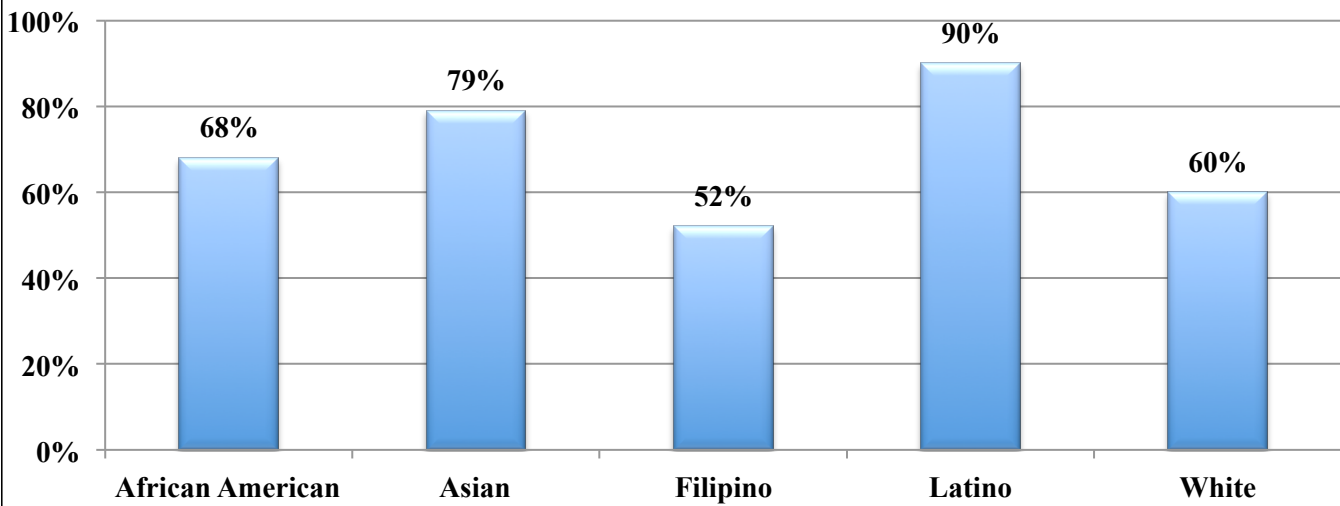
Fall 2013 Students by Race-ethnicity

Chabot College serves a diverse population of 13,500 students in five major ethnic groups. Between 50 and 90 percent of each ethnic group are first generation college* students.

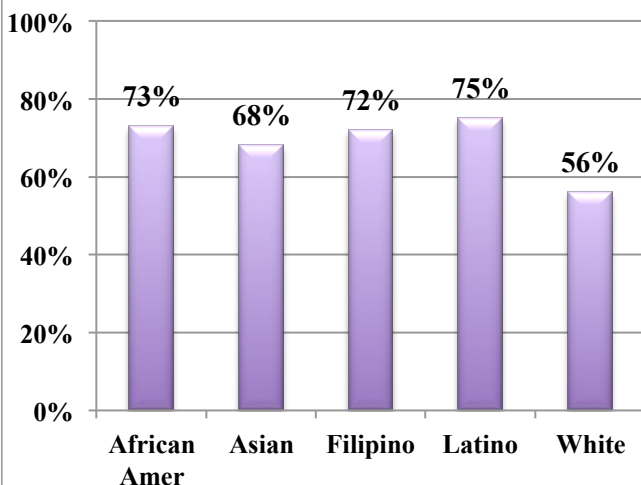

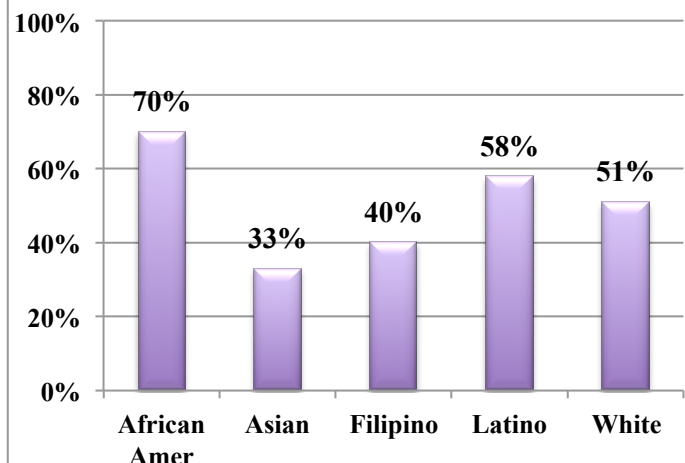
Percentage of First Generation College Students within Race-Ethnicity Groups
