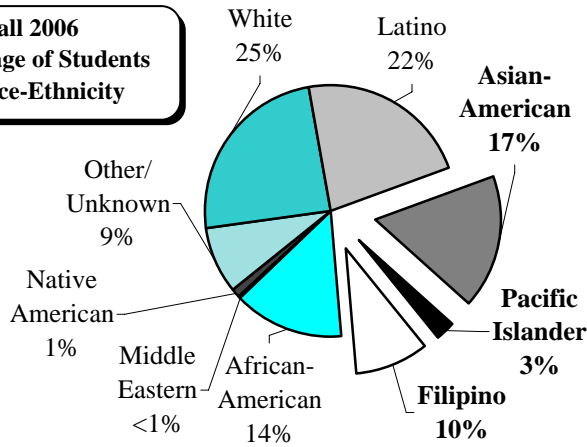

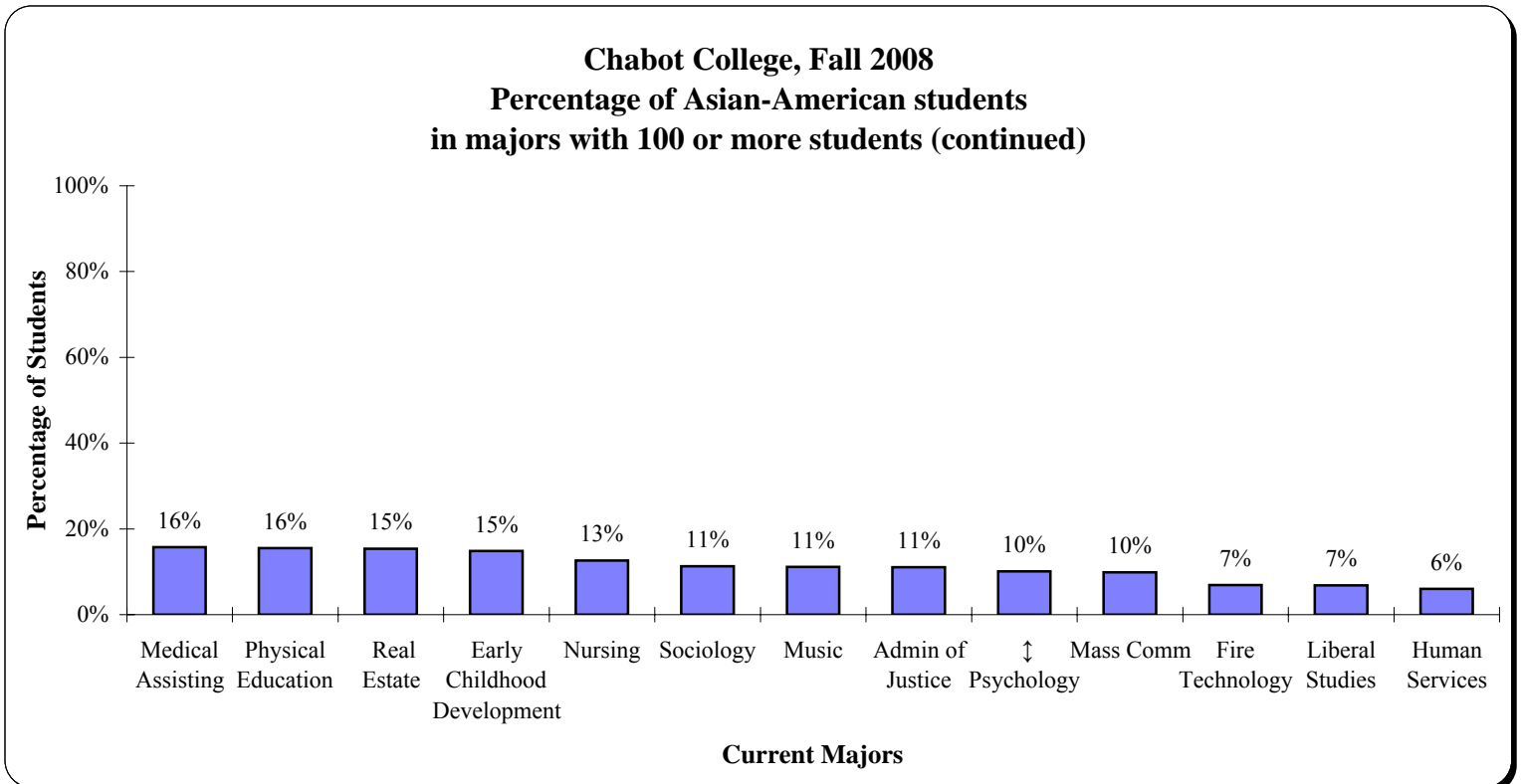
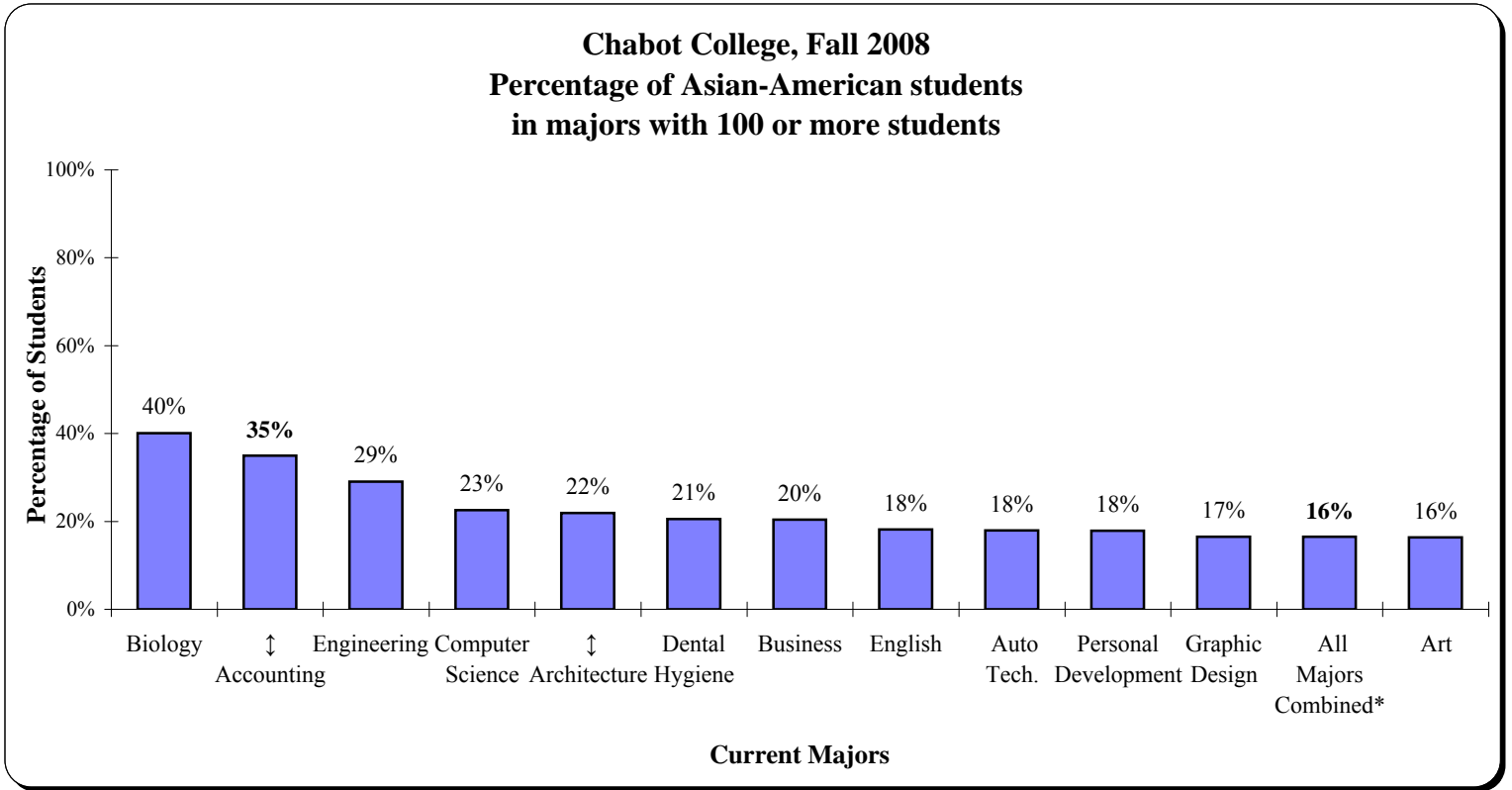

Representation of Asian-American Students in largest Majors at Chabot

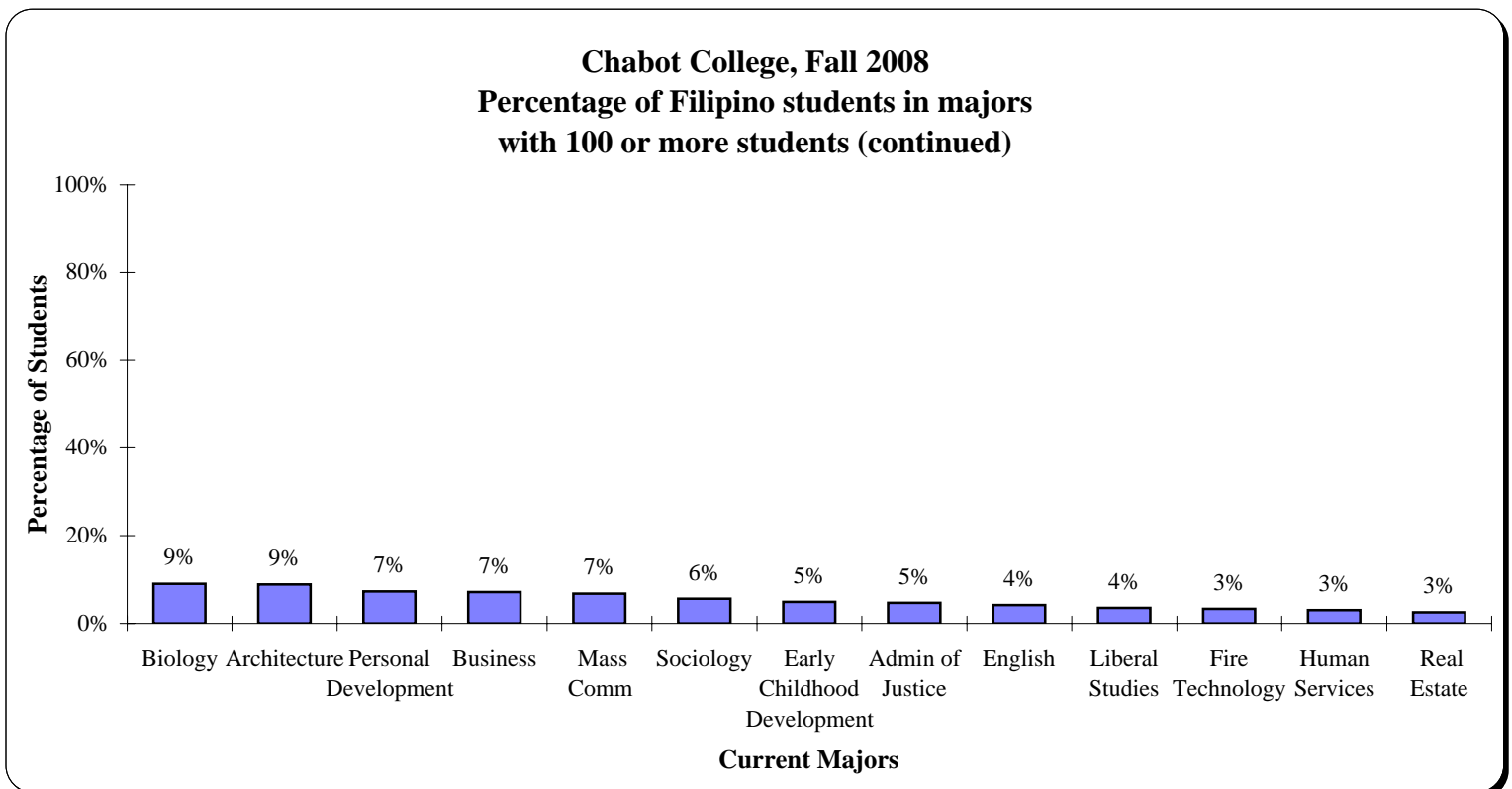
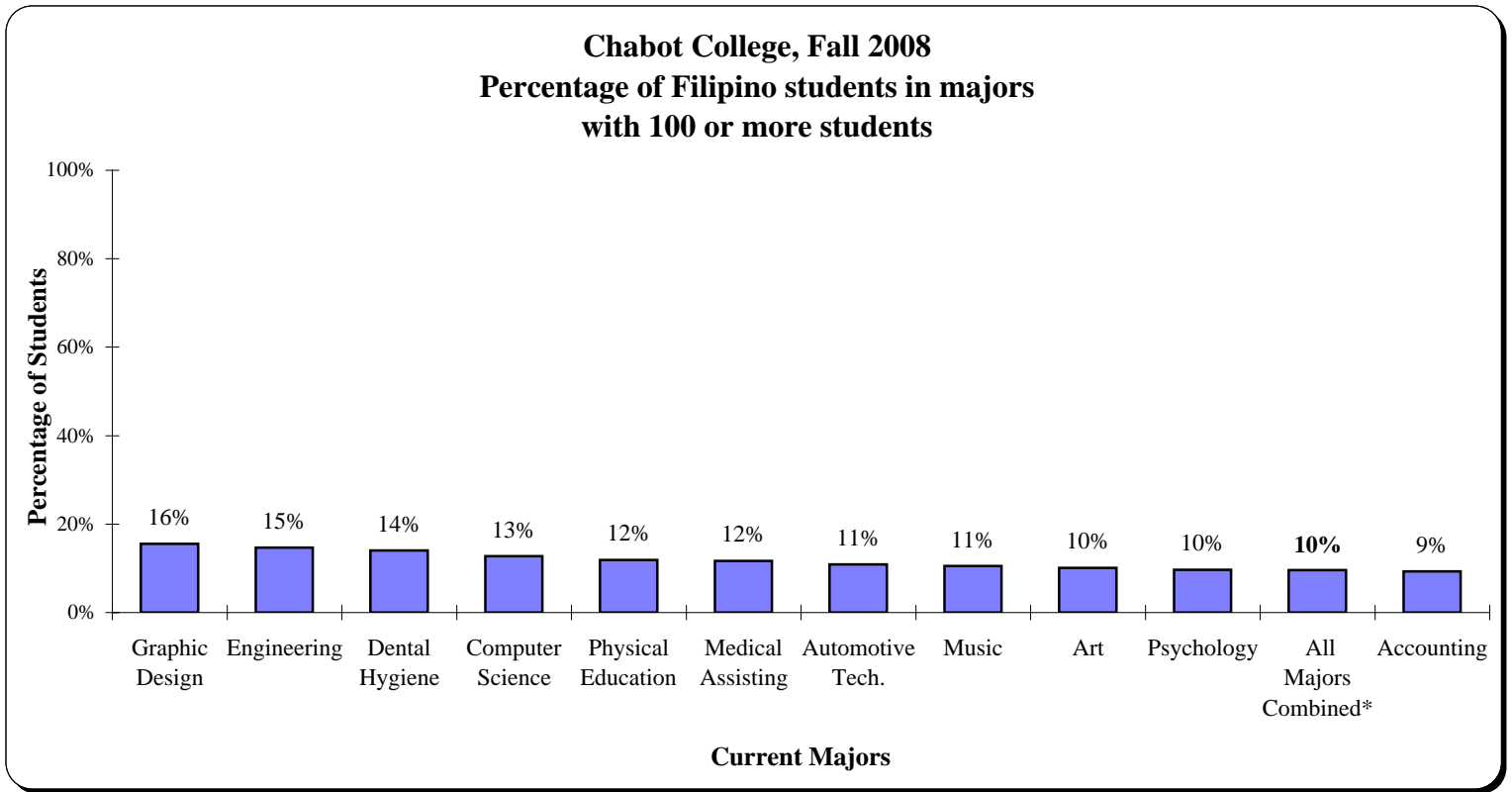

Representation of Filipino Students in largest Majors at Chabot



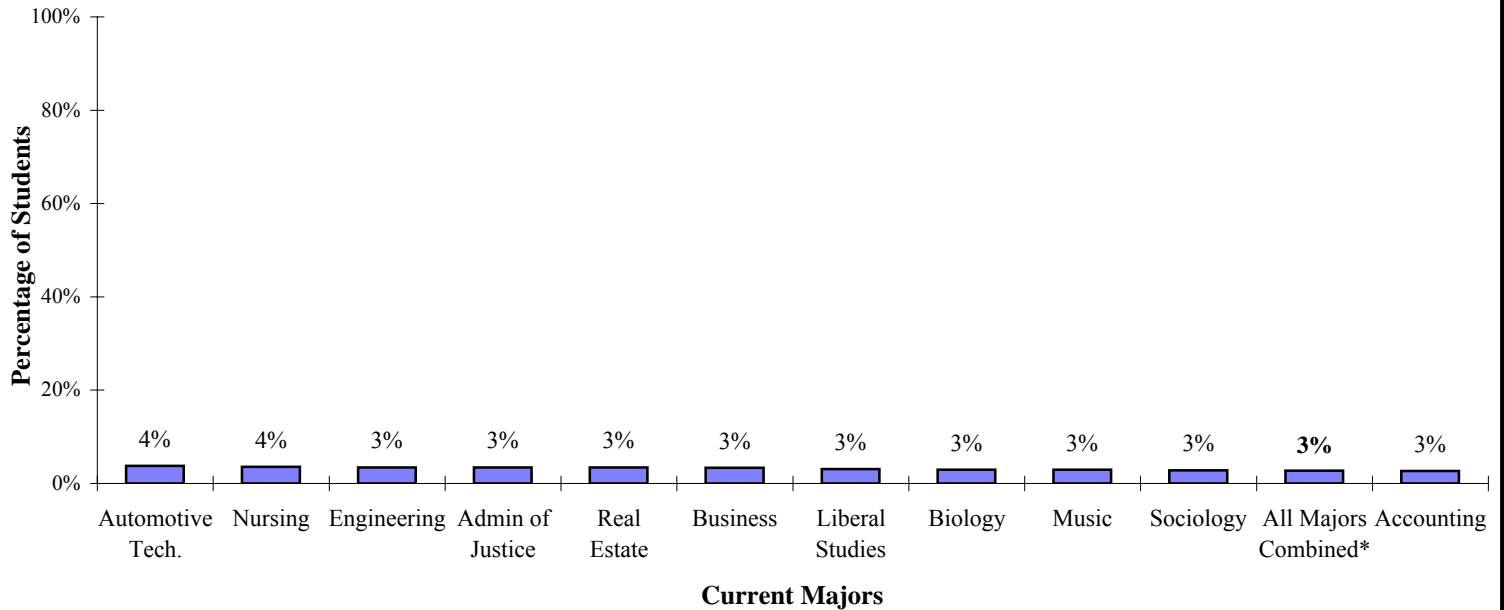

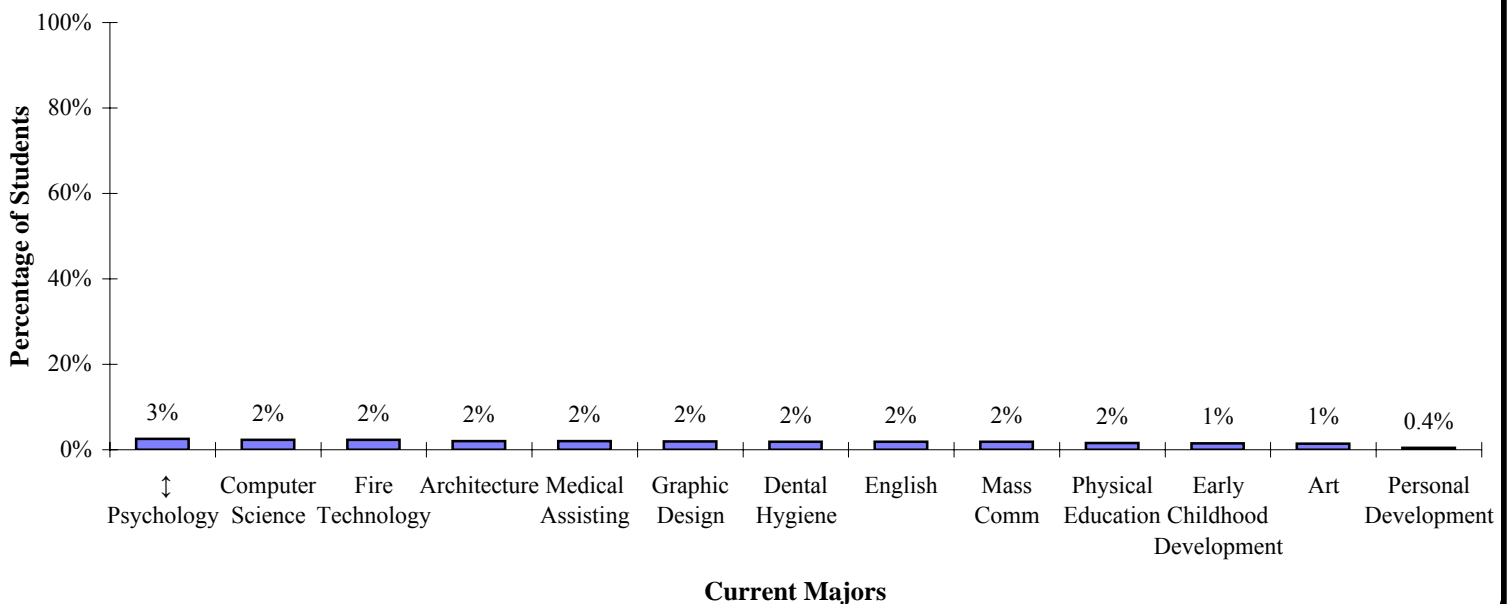
Pacific Islander Students at Chabot College
