## Chabot College Student Characteristics Fall 2018 Dreamers, Latinx, & All Students

In Fall 2018, 448 Dreamers attended Chabot, making up three percent of the student body. Dreamers are students who are undocumented. A typical Dreamer student is a 19 year-old or younger Latinx woman. Like most Chabot students and most Latinx students, the Dreamers were likely to be enrolled in less than 12 units, attend during the day only, and have the educational goal of transferring to a four-year college or university.

Dreamers earned 2 percent of degrees in 2018 which is similar to their representation on campus. They also earned 6 percent of certificates, which is more than their representation on campus.
