

Chabot College Student Characteristics Fall 2018

Students with Educational Goals of Transfer/Degree, Job Training, or Undecided

Out of 14,501 Chabot students in Fall 2018, 62% had the goal of earning an AA degree and/or transferring to a 4-year college, while 17% came to Chabot for job training. Another 11% were undecided about their educational goal.

Transfer/ Degree students and undecided students were similar in many student characteristics. The undecided students were slightly more likely to be older, have an AA or BA degree, or be in high school. Consequently, they were much less likely to attend Chabot full-time.

However, the students coming to Chabot for job training were very different from the other two groups. Almost half were 30 years or older, and one fifth had a BA degree. More than half were taking less than 6 units; few attended full-time. Approximately one third were attending at night. They were much more likely to come from other California cities and Districts, while the Transfer/Degree and undecided students were more local.
