Chabot College Trends in Student Educational Goals: Falls 2000-2021

Students stated their educational goal when they submitted their application to Chabot. Between Fall 2000 and Fall 2021, the educational goals of Chabot students changed considerably in the last twenty-one years. The percentage of students intending to transfer to a 4-year college increased from 40% in 2000 to 53% in 2021, and the percentage of students with personal development goals dropped to 6% in 2021. Likewise, the percentage of those who intended to earn an A.A. or A.S. degree without transfering dropped from 10% to 8% over the past twenty-one years. The percentage of students who are undecided remained about 22% for many years, but recently declined to 11%.
