Trends in High School Districts of First-time College Students: Fall 2001-2013

New first-time college students make up about 17 percent of the student body, and for the last 13 years they have come from a similar mix of high school districts. Half of Chabot first-time college students went to high schools in the Chabot College District. Only 12 percent came from high schools in other parts of Alameda County, a decline from 25 percent in Fall 03. Over 20 percent came from other areas of California (such as Contra Costa county). The percentage of new students who went to high school in a different country declined from 11 percent to 6 percent.
