
Chabot College Trends in High School Districts of First-time College Students: Fall 2002-2014

New first-time college students make up about 17 percent of the student body, and for the last 13 years they have come from a similar mix of high school districts. Half of Chabot first-time college students went to high schools in the Chabot College District. Only 14 percent came from high schools in other parts of Alameda County, a decline from 20 percent in Fall 2003. About 12 percent came from other parts of the Bay Area or elsewhere in California. The percentage of new students who went to high school in a different country declined from 10 percent to 5 percent.
