Chabot College Student Characteristics: Fall 2017 Part-time Students compared to Full-time students

Out of 14,196 Chabot students taking credit units in Fall 2017, 69% attended part-time: 39% took 6-11 units and 30% took less than 6 units. Part-time students taking 6-11 units were somewhat similar to full-time students. However, part-time students taking less than 6 units were quite a bit different from the full-time students and the part-time students taking more units. These students were *much more likely* to be Latino or older, transfer from another college, have a BA/BS or higher degree, attend in the evening or Saturday, take an online class, and have a job training goal.
