## **Chabot College Student Characteristics: Fall 2018 Part-time Students compared to Full-time students**

Out of 14,238 Chabot students taking credit units in Fall 2018, 69% attended part-time: 36% took 6-11.5 units and 33% took less than 6 units. Part-time students taking 6-11.5 units were somewhat similar to full-time students. However, part-time students taking less than 6 units were quite different from the full-time students and the part-time students taking more units. These students were *much more likely* to be Latinx or older, transfer from another college, have a BA/BS or higher degree, attend in the evening or Saturday, take an online class, and have a job training goal.
