

## Chabot College Student Characteristics: Fall 2021

### Part-time Students compared to Full-time students

Out of 11,991 Chabot students taking credit units in Fall 2020, 69% attended part-time: 34% took 6-11.5 units and 35% took less than 6 units. Part-time students taking 6-11.5 units were somewhat similar to full-time students in their educational goals, enrollment status and patterns. Part-time students taking less than 6 units were quite different from full-time students and part-time students who take more units. These students were ***much more likely*** to be older, to have transferred from another college, have a BA/BS or higher degree, take an online class, and have a personal development goal.

# Chabot College Student Characteristics: Fall 2017

## Part-time Students compared to Full-time students

Out of 14,196 Chabot students taking credit units in Fall 2017, 69% attended part-time: 39% took 6-11 units and 30% took less than 6 units. Part-time students taking 6-11 units were somewhat similar to full-time students. However, part-time students taking less than 6 units were quite a bit different from the full-time students and the part-time students taking more units. These students were ***much more likely*** to be Latino or older, transfer from another college, have a BA/BS or higher degree, attend in the evening or Saturday, take an online class, and have a job training goal.
