Chabot College Trends in Previous College of Transfer Students: Fall 2000-2021

Students who transfer into Chabot from other colleges comprise about 19% of the student body, and the colleges they transferred from have somewhat changed in the last 21 years. More than half of the transfers now come from other California community colleges; this percentage used to be about 46 percent. The percentage of transfers from California State University has declined from 17% to 15%, while the percentage of transfers from University of California has remained relatively unchanged at around 5%.
