## Title III goals related to Basic Skills to be met by September 2013

- 1. Increase success and persistence in basic skills courses
- 2. Increase success and persistence in courses supported by learning support services.
- 3. Maintain and increase enrollment by increasing persistence.

## Title III objectives met

## All-college objectives

- Increase in success rates in ALL basic skills courses combined.
- Increase in fall to fall persistence for ALL students in basic skills courses
- Increase in fall to fall persistence for ALL degree-seeking students
- Increase in the percent of all successful Math 65 and Math 55 students who succeed in the next higher course.

## Objectives for FIG (Title III/Basic Skills-funded) courses

- Increase in engagement in all FIG basic skills English courses
- Increase in success rates in all English classes with learning assistants
- Increase in engagement for students who use learning assistants in their classes.
- Increase in success rates for individual FIG classes and tutoring

## Title III objectives NOT met

## Objectives for FIG (Title III/Basic Skills-funded) courses

- No increase in success rates in overall FIG basic skills English and Math classes and Math classes with learning assistants.
- No increase in persistence in percent of all successful Basic Skills English students who succeed in next higher course this was already high.
- No increase in persistence in percent of all successful Math 104/105 students who succeed in next higher course.
- No overall increase in engagement in FIG basic skills Math classes or classes with learning assistants.
- No increase in persistence in classes with learning assistants.
- Few differences in comparisons between FIG and non-FIG classes, or classes with and without learning assistants on success rates, persistence, or engagement. (Bar was too high)

# Other Basic Skills progress measures: increases, decreases, or no increases *Increases*

- Increase in success rates overall for English, Math, and ESL separately.
- Some increases in success in next higher Math course for Basic Skills students (in T3)
- Recent increase in Fall to Spring persistence for all new students and each ethnic group.
- Recent increase in Pct of Laser & Seeker Basic Skills students completing BS Eng within 1 yr.
- Recent increase in Pct of Laser Basic Skills students completing College Eng within 1 yr.

#### Decreases or No Increases

- Continued but smaller differences by ethnicity in success and persistence in Basic Skills English.
- No increases in success in next higher English or Math course for Basic Skills students (in T3)
- Recent decreases in Laser College and Seeker College completing College Eng within 1 yr.
- Decrease in Scorecard completion rates for BS and College cohorts 2002-03 to 2006-07 after 6 yrs. Educational Goal Groups for 2006-07 cohort: transfer-ready depends on full vs. part-time.
