

ACCJC's Institutional Effectiveness Indicators: Institution-Set Standards and Stretch Goals

2020-21 Goal-Setting

Background

ACCJC is the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges. For accreditation purposes, institutions are required to set two types of goals: 1) an Institution-Set Standard: a minimum baseline value that we should not drop below, the "floor", and 2) a Stretch Goal: a goal above our current level of performance that we aspire to achieve. The Office of Institutional Research develops goal suggestions based on the past five years of data and a standard deviation method of goal setting. These suggested goals are then presented to the Planning and Resource Allocation Committee for modification and/or approval. This document includes the ACCJC goals established at Chabot, as well as updates on our progress in reaching these goals. When data is not available, the boxes were marked as N/A.
