

## **Enrollments by Course Modality and Race/Ethnicity Spring 2022-Fall 2022**

From Spring 2022 to Fall 2022, there was an increase in the percentage of enrollments in face-to-face courses for all racial/ethnic groups. For example, African American/Black students had 22% of their enrollments in face-to-face (FTF) classes in Spring 2022, and that increased to 32% in Fall 2022. Latino/a/x students had 26% of their enrollments in face-to face classes in Spring 2022, and that increased to 36% in Fall 2022.

Across all racial and ethnic student groups, students were enrolled in more online asynchronous courses than any other modality. In both Spring 2022 and Fall 2022, African American/Black and Pacific Islander students have the highest percentage enrollments in online asynchronous classes, compared to other racial/ethnic groups.

<sup>\*\*</sup>Other/Unknown includes apprenticeship classes, dual enrollment classes, and Sheriff's Academy classes. The course modality information of these classes is not contained in the IR dataset; hence they are coded as 'Other/Unknown.'
