

Chabot College Degree and Certificate Graduates Workforce Trends from 2000 to 2013

Summary

The percentage of Chabot graduates planning to transfer to a 4-year institution has remained around 45 percent for the last 13 years. The percentage who are planning to work has fallen from 53 percent to 44 percent in the last six years. About one third of graduates are planning to use their degree/certificate in a new career, and around 40 percent will use it in a new job in the same career.

The Graduate Survey is given every other year to degree and certificate graduates who attend the Spring graduation ceremony. About one third of the graduates attend, and two thirds of those attending fill out a survey. So the survey results are more representative of those attending graduation than of all graduates. However, it does give us a glimpse of the immediate plans of these successful graduates.

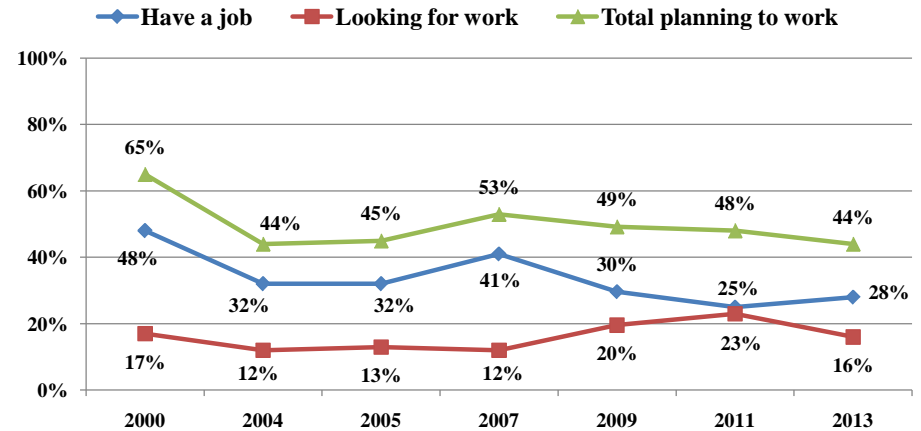
