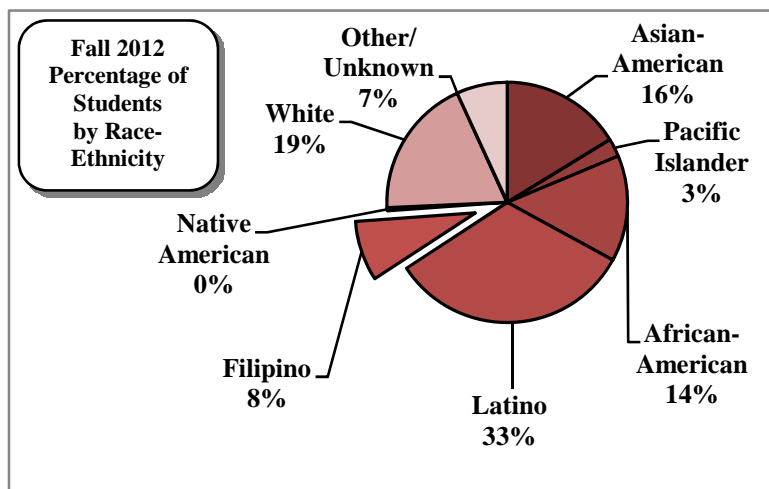


Filipino Students at Chabot College: Success and Persistence

These tables show the latest course success and persistence rates of Filipino students at Chabot by gender, age, student type, and educational goal. Filipino students have similar success and persistence rates as all Chabot students, and higher rates in some cases. These Filipino students have higher success rates than all Chabot students: 19 or younger, 25 or older, new students, and students with AA/AS degree and job training goals. These Filipino students have higher persistence rates than all Chabot students: women and men 19 or younger, new women and men students, and new students with transfer goals.
