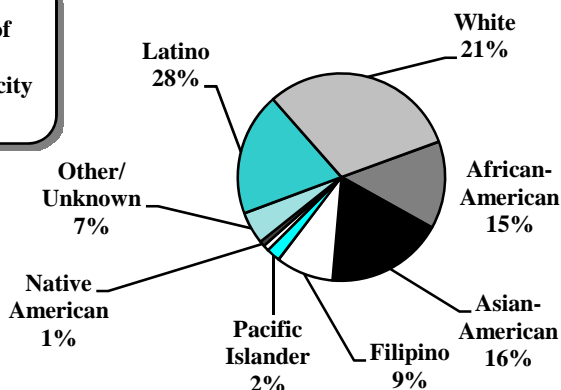


Native American Students at Chabot College: Success and Persistence

These tables show the latest course success and persistence rates of Native American students at Chabot by gender, age, student type, and educational goal. Native American students have similar success rates and persistence rates as all Chabot students. Success rates are highest among women ages 20-21 and 40 or older, transfer, new transfer, AA/AS degree goals, and continuing students. Persistence rates are highest among women ages 20-21 and men ages 20-21, new students, AA/AS degree goals and continuing students.
