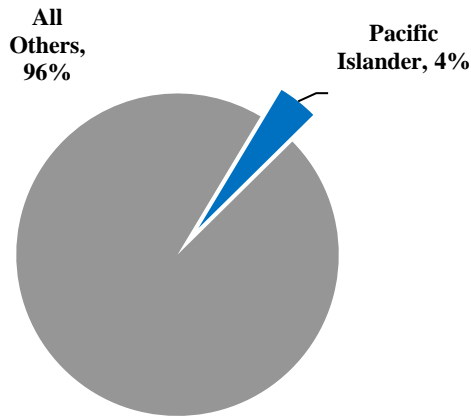


Pacific Islander Students at Chabot College: Success and Persistence

These tables show the latest course success and persistence rates of Pacific Islander students at Chabot by gender, age, student type, and educational goal. Pacific Islander students have lower success rates and lower persistence rates than all Chabot students. Among Pacific Islander students, success rates are highest among students 25-29 years old, and those with AA/AS or job training goals. Persistence rates are highest among women and men 19 years or younger, and those with transfer or job training goals.
