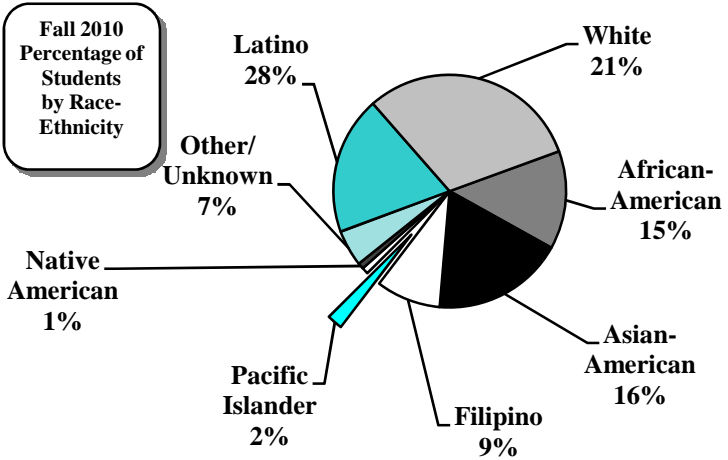


# Pacific Islander Students at Chabot College: Success and Persistence

These tables show the latest course success and persistence rates of Pacific Islander students at Chabot by gender, age, student type, and educational goal. Pacific Islander students have slightly lower success rates than all Chabot students. However, Pacific Islander students have higher persistence rates than all Chabot students. Among Pacific Islander students, success rates are highest among older students, returning students, and those with AA degree and job training goals. Persistence rates are highest among men, those aged 19 and younger, new and continuing students, and those with transfer and degree goals.
