From ADMISSIONS & RECORDS

We have only one scheduled drop for non-payment day for Spring - Students who registered for Spring 09 between November 3 and December 1 **must pay their outstanding enrollment fees for Spring by December 10 or they will be drop for non-payment on December 12th.**

As in the past, if a fee increase is approved A&R will not reassess accounts until the effective date.

The deadline for automatic Ws for full-term was November 9th. Students who wish to withdraw from full-term classes must now submit extenuating circumstance withdrawal petitions to the Dean of Counseling. The deadline is December 17.

AA DEGREE MATH REQUIREMENT IS CHANGING

beginning Fall 09, Math 55 (Intermediate Algebra) will be required for an AA Degree--statewide. I just found out (that this also means that Business 16 (Business Math) will NO LONGER meet the AA Degree requirement. So it appears that ALL students wanting an AA Degree will have to get through Math 55.

If a student started Chabot BEFORE Fall09 and maintains his/her catalog rights (meaning that they HAVE to enroll in at least 1 class at Chabot per year), the old requirement applies.

TRANSFERRING TO CSU?

Their deadlines for Winter and Spring is November 30th, with no late applications. At this time there is no change to our Fall 2009 deadline (August 31, 2009) but I would advise students not to wait too long if they are considering Fall. To apply for CSU, go to www.csumentor.edu .

If you want a waiver of the \$55 application fee, make a PACE Counseling appointment to complete a Transfer Admission Guarantee. You will need to wait 4-6 weeks until you receive a

letter from CSUEB explaining the application process before you can complete the online CSU Mentor application. If a student applies and pays for the application before they receive a letter from CSU EB, they will not get reimbursed!

WHAT'S A MAJOR RESTRICTION"??

If you are trying to Register into a PACE class, and are denied access with the message "Major Restriction", it means that you are not "flagged" in the computer as a PACE student. Every semester PACE restricts certain classes so that only PACE students can register into them for the first few weeks of the Registration period. If you are told "Major Restriction" then the computer doesn't know that this class is for you! Contact Julie at jmachado@chabotcollege.edu to clear your Major Restriction.
