Also, 1 unit of PE 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 12, 13, 13R, 14, 30-48, or 50 is required for an AA Degree for students starting Chabot in Fall 2002 or later. PE is not offered in PACE, but there are many evening, weekend, and online PE classes.

Additional Courses Required:

CSUEB Business Major Requirements:

(not available through PACE, but available in the evening)

- **Business 1A** (strongly recommended Bus 7 prereq), **1B, 10**
- **CAS 50** or **8**
- **Math** (after completing Math 55): **31, 43 & 15**
- **Economics 1 & 2** (strongly recommended eligibility for English 1A & Math 55).

If you want to get your Chabot AA in Business Administration as well, you also need **Bus 12**.

All PACE courses are both degree-applicable and CSU transferable, *except*: Math 105 and English 102, which are neither; and Math 65 and 55, which are not CSU transferable.
