Vision

Definition

A statement that paints a picture of where the college intends to be in the future, like a guiding light. It usually ranges in length from a short slogan to one sentence. It can be inspiring or evocative.

Question for input:

Please provide 1 to 3 examples of phrases that evoke for you possible visions for the college.

Mission

Definition

A statement that

- *informs the public of the purpose of the organization
- *distinguishes the community college from other kinds of educational institutions
- *defines the population to be served.
- *expresses the college's commitment to student learning

Questions for input:

- 1) What do you see as the purpose of Chabot College? What is our function? (20 words or less)

- 2) What makes Chabot College different from other colleges, and other community colleges?

- 3) What population(s) are we here to serve?

Philosophy and Values

Definition

These are statements of values and beliefs that express the educational and cultural philosophy of how and why we teach, learn, and work at the college. They create a unique and distinctive tone or climate for the college.

Question for input:

Please provide a list of 3 to 5 values or beliefs that express for you how and why we teach, learn, and work at Chabot.
