Conclusions from the data:

- 1. The numbers for those who used the Language Center are too small to make any strong conclusions.
- 2. Overall success rates were lower for students who received Language services than those who did not receive Language Center services. The comparison group may not be the best because those who sought Language Center services might not have been be doing well in their classes.
- 3. Students with appointments at the Language Center had a higher success rate than those who dropped-in or did not use the Language Center.
- 4. Students who used the Language Center did not withdraw from their ESL classes.
