Chabot College Faculty/Staff Accreditation Survey: Spring 2014 Highlights

Standard IIIA: Human Resources: Staff Development

While nearly three quarters of all staff feel supported by their administrators/supervisors to participate in professional development, there were significant decreases in the college's ability to provide resources and trainings to improve job or teaching skills since the Spring 2008 accreditation survey. The Faculty/Staff Accreditation Survey was sent to all Chabot staff in March 2014. The overall response rate was 64 percent, with 94% of part-time classified professionals, 83% of full-time classified, 46% of part-time faculty, 76% of full-time faculty, and 86% of administrators represented.
