Chabot College Faculty/Staff Accreditation Survey: Spring 2014 Highlights

Standard IIIB: Physical Resources: Physical Environment

The majority of faculty, full-time classified professionals, and administrators felt that the college does not adequately maintain current facilities. They were especially dissatisfied with the custodial services and campus landscaping and playing fields. There is a concern that there are not sufficient personnel or resources to maintain the buildings and grounds. However, Campus Safety got high marks for responding quickly, maintaining a safe campus, and providing emergency training. The Faculty/Staff Accreditation Survey was sent to all Chabot staff in March 2014. There were 371 responses for an overall response rate of 64 percent, with 94% of part-time classified professionals, 83% of full-time classified professionals, 46% of part-time faculty, 76% of full-time faculty, and 86% of administrators represented.
