Standard IIIB: Physical Resources: Facilities and Equipment

The campus is in the midst of an extensive Bond-funded construction period. Staff responses about facilities depended on whether their area is undergoing construction or not. Those whose areas were going through changes were more likely to be familiar with and to have provided input to the Facilities Plan; they also felt more positively about the planned future facilities than those not going through construction felt about their current facilities. However, all staff felt that Chabot facilities support student learning.

The Faculty/Staff Accreditation Survey was sent to all Chabot staff and District staff at Chabot in March 2008. The overall response rate was 62 percent, with 77 percent of full-time faculty, 84 percent of full-time classified, and 100% of administrators represented. Almost half of adjunct faculty and one third of hourly staff responded.
