

CHABOT COLLEGE FACULTY/STAFF ACCREDITATION SURVEY: SPRING 2008

Highlights

Standard III B: Physical Resources: Physical Environment

The majority of faculty, full-time classified professionals, and administrators felt that the college adequately maintains current facilities. They were especially satisfied with the custodial services and campus landscaping and playing fields. However, there is a concern that there are not sufficient personnel or resources to maintain the buildings and grounds. Campus Safety got high marks for responding quickly, maintaining a safe campus, and providing emergency training.

The Faculty/Staff Accreditation Survey was sent to all Chabot staff and District staff at Chabot in March 2008. The overall response rate was 62 percent, with 77 percent of full-time faculty, 84 percent of full-time classified, and 100% of administrators represented. Almost half of adjunct faculty and one third of hourly staff responded.
