Chabot College Student Accreditation Survey: Fall 2013 Highlights

Campus climate for Latino and African American Students

Feeling welcome and encouraging others to attend Chabot are two indicators of the campus climate for students. Latino and African American students have been feeling increasingly welcome at Chabot in the past four years, although African Americans experienced a slight decrease in that feeling in Fall 2013. Still, about 80 percent of each group continued to feel welcome, according to the Fall 2013 student survey.

The percentage of Latino and African American students who encourage others to attend Chabot has remained near the high of 81 and 82 percent, respectively, in Fall 2009. In Fall 2013, it was only slightly below that at 78-79%. The Student Accreditation Survey was conducted in October 2013 in a representative sample of 68 classes. Surveys were completed by 1,597 students (59% full-time; 41% part-time).
