Students can self-place into either a two-semester developmental sequence (Eng 101A-101B, 8 units) or an accelerated one-semester course (Eng 102, 4 units).





Students Taking Developmental English for First Time in Fall 2004, 2005, 2006, or 2007*



In addition to the composition sequence, there are also ESL classes (ESL 110A-110D) and courses targeted to students with learning disabilities (Eng 116-118). Students can voluntarily choose these courses, or may be directed to them by college assessment process. However, they can also self- place directly in English 101A or 102. 23% of the above English 102 students were enrolled in a learning community.


