Chabot CalWORKs is a program of services for TANF / AFDC recipients intended to help families receiving state aid achieve economic self sufficiency. The program serves CalWORKs students by providing educational and career opportunities that enable students to complete their educational goals, find meaningful employment, and successfully transition into the workforce. Our CalWORKs program supports economic self-sufficiency through the attainment of higher education, as well as part-time work experience opportunities.

Chabot College provides accelerated comprehensive workforce solutions to Southern Alameda County residents and beyond. Accelerated courses and programs allow for flexible scheduling and are designed for new career seekers and working adults, in addition to welfare recipients who are looking for practical education and training.
