2. Registering to vote and voting in California.
3. Licensing from California for professional practices.
4. Active membership in services or social clubs.
5. Presence of spouse, children, or other close relatives in the state.
6. Showing California as home address on federal income tax form.
7. Payment of California state income tax as a resident.
8. Possessing California motor vehicle license plate.
9. Possessing a California driver's license.
10. Maintaining permanent military address or home of record in California with the armed forces.
11. Establishing and maintaining active California bank accounts.
12. Being the petitioner for a divorce in California.

According to Title 5 section 54024, conduct inconsistent with a claim of California residence includes but is not limited to:

1. Maintaining voter registration and voting in another state
2. Being the petitioner for a divorce in another state.
3. Attending an out-of-state institution as a resident of that other state.
4. Declaring non-residence in California for state income tax purposes.
