

ASCC SPECIAL MEETING- 27 OCTOBER, 2008

1.0- OPEN SESSION- CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

1.1 Call to Order- This special meeting was called to order at 3:09 PM.

3.0- ACTION ITEMS

3.1 Halloween Costume Contest Party- Flores proposed a total of \$960.00. Cornejo motioned to approve said amount, Flores seconded. Advisor Nancy Soto discussed concern that KCRH and 94.9 FM would be organizing similar events at the same time. Soto voiced that Flores' event looked like an event that was too quickly set up. Soto finally stressed that an incumbent needs to be set up to review ASCC account, and that more dialogue needs to exist between KCRH and ASCC. Flores protested that the ASCC is not able to successfully communicate with KCRH.

According to reports from Nichols and Flores, KCRH does not act upon protocol when establishing lease and funds for events. Soto stressed that the two organizations working on the same date does not look good for Chabot College. She stated that KCRH has one of the larger accounts of clubs on campus. If accounts do well, generally, then the ASCC does not tend to lease money to such a club. Finally, it was stated that such events need to be represented and handled by ICC Chair. Flores said that an event for KCRH needed to be planned in advance. Three weeks were given in advance for KCRH to plan its event, but they were unable to meet this

deadline. Thus, three weeks had passed with any type of budgetary plan

Action Taken: All voted in favor of passing said amount (\$960) for Halloween Costume Contest with the exception for Cornejo.
