Piano for Kids

After taking this four-week introductory group class, students with little or no prior experience will be able to read and play 20 songs (classical, folk and blues) using both hands in treble and bass clef. You'll be playing your first song on the first day! You'll also learn chord progression that will serve as a basis to play many other songs when the lessons are over or go on to continue your piano education. Ages 10-17. Limit 15 students. Notes: Must have keyboard or piano to practice on for 15-20 minutes a day. Intermediate students are welcome and will be given higher-level instruction *Instructor: Kathleen Nelson*.
