- 3. **Uses Evidence-Based Strategies** Are activities supported by <u>research</u> and can affect change and "move the needle" for Di Group(s).
- **4. Sufficient Methodology for Data Collection –** Clearly detailed and feasible plan for data collection.
- 5. Measureable Goals by DI Group that can be Evaluated Specific goals for both outputs (service deliverables) and outcomes (impact on DI groups). Needs to also include timelines for achievement.
- **6.** Transformative Potential of Project Does the project demonstrate transformative potential for DI Groups. Transformative is defined as, "creating personal and/or community level change in agency towards racial & social justice consciousness and outcomes."
- 7. Funding Request Reasonable Is the amount proportional to scale of impact.
- **8.** Targets DI Group in Community target group is historically under-represented and under-served in community (Distinct from DI Group On-Campus).
