

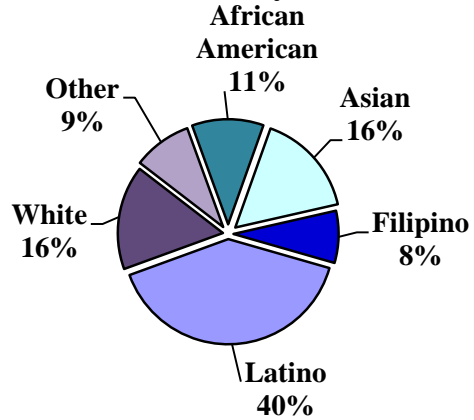

Diverse, First Generation Students Starting at Basic Skills Levels

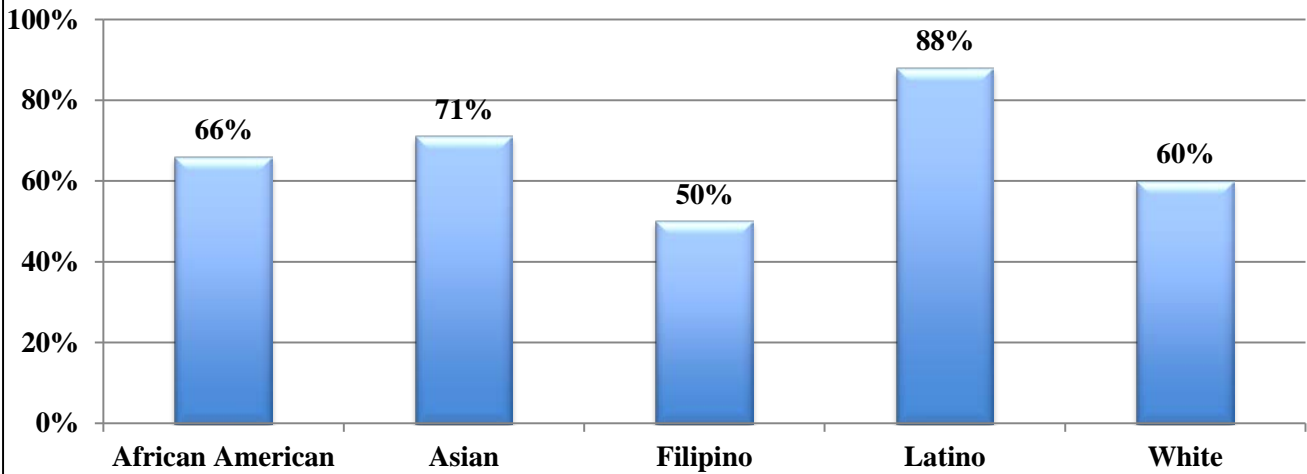
Chabot College serves a diverse population of 14,402 students in five major ethnic groups. Between 50 and 88 percent of each ethnic group are first generation college* students.

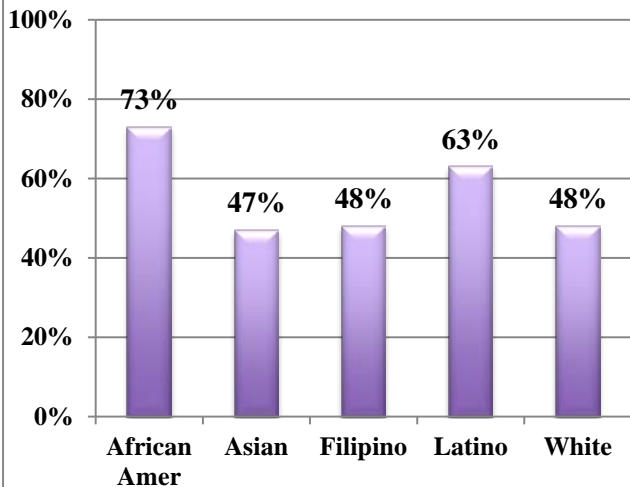
Fall 2017 Students by Race-ethnicity



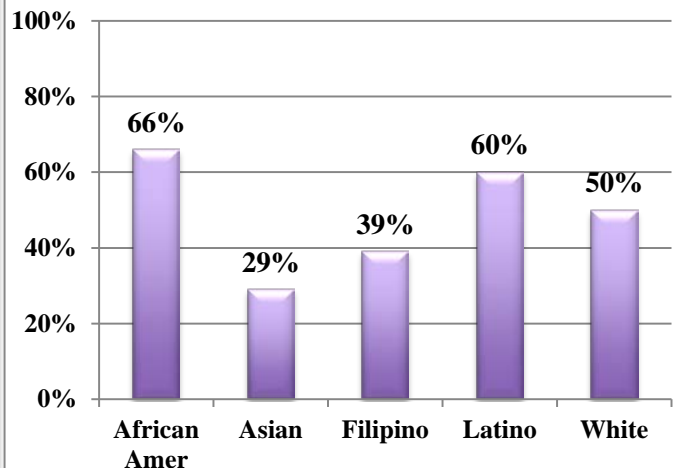
Percentage of First Generation College Students within Race-Ethnicity Groups
