English Assessment: Fall 2015 , Fall 2016, and Fall 2017 Changes and Results

For Fall 15, Fall 16, & Fall 17, the English/ESL faculty and the SSSP Advisory Group approved the following changes to the English Assessment test:

Fall 15 Changes	<i>Changes from Fall 2014 to Fall 2015 in Cut Score to be placed into English 1A:</i>	Accuplacer Reading Score lowered from 85 to 80 Accuplacer Sentence Structure Score lowered from 95 to 80
Fall 16 Changes	<i>Changes from Fall 2015 to Fall 2016 in Cut Score to be placed into English 1A:</i>	NO CHANGE in Reading Score or Sentence Structure Score ADDED Reading Score \geq 40 and a H.S. GPA of 3.5 or higher
Fall 17 Changes	<i>Changes from Fall 2016 to Fall 2017</i>	NO CHANGE in Eng 1A Cut Score or H.S. GPA of 3.5 or higher Low-scoring ESL students branched down to ESL test, so not included in total.
