Chabot College Trends in High School Districts of First-time College Students: Fall 2002-2017

New first-time college students make up about 17 percent of the student body, and for the last 14 years they have come from a similar mix of high school districts. Until Fall 2008, barely half of Chabot first-time college students came from high schools in the Chabot College District. Since then, the percentage from local high schools has been over half of new students, reaching a high of 57 percent in Fall 2016, yet decreased to 54 percent in 2017. Only 11 percent came from high schools in other parts of Alameda County, a decline from 20 percent in Fall 2004. About 11 percent came from other parts of the Bay Area or elsewhere in California. The percentage of new students who went to high school in a different country decreased from 7 percent to 6 percent.
