
Chabot College Student Satisfaction Survey: Fall 2015 Highlights


Student Satisfaction with Chabot Steadily Rising


Student satisfaction with Chabot keeps rising! In Fall 2015, Chabot students were equally or more satisfied with Chabot overall, campus climate, instructors, student services, and facilities than in previous years.

The highest satisfaction with Chabot in the last 20 years was in October 2001, right after 9/11, when the campus pulled together to support all groups on campus. After a subsequent drop, satisfaction has steadily grown in overall satisfaction and campus climate. In the last two years, several areas — being treated with respect by faculty and staff, and respect for differences in race-ethnicity and in gender —surpassed their 2001 levels of satisfaction.

The Student Satisfaction Survey was conducted in October 2015 in a representative sample of 81 on-campus course sections. Surveys were completed by 1,667 students (56% full-time; 44% part-time).
