Transfer Degrees Continue to Rise

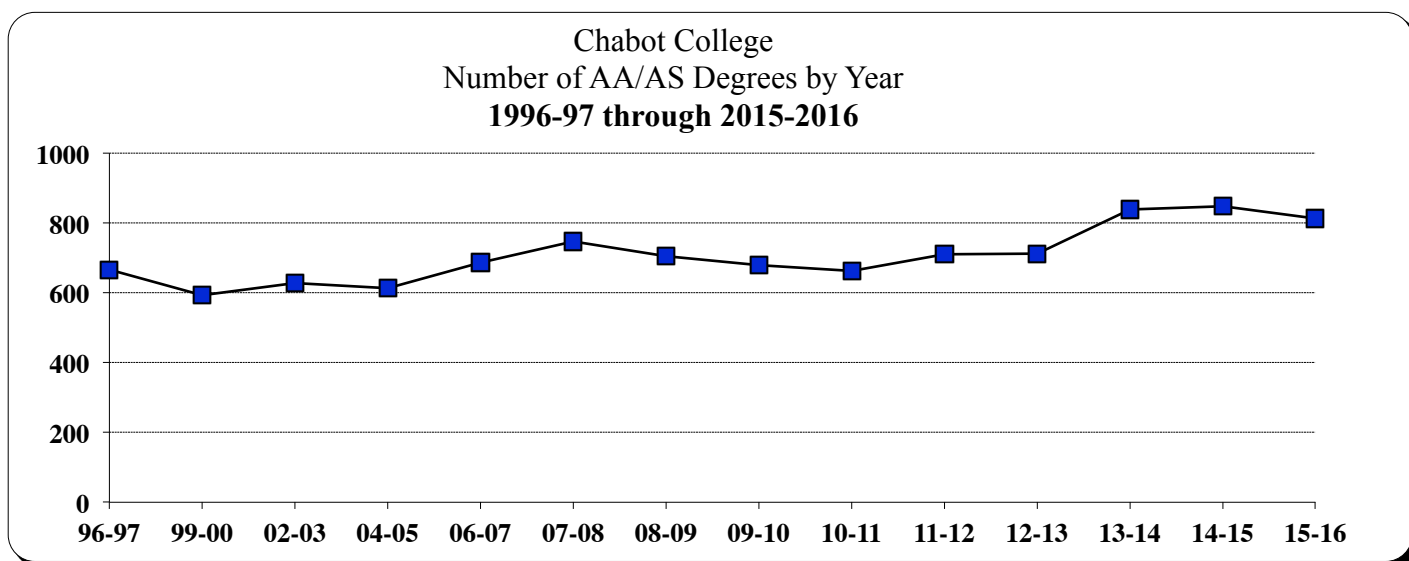
In 2015-16, transfer degrees continued to increase among Chabot graduates, while most other AA/AS degrees declined or did not change. Faculty worked hard to create transfer degrees, which allow students to graduate with a degree, meet CSU transfer requirements, and have a guaranteed a place at CSU. Students apparently love them.

For 3 years, transfer degrees have pushed the number of Chabot degrees to over 800, the highest in 20 years. In 2015-16, the other AA/AS degrees that also increased were in Computer Science, Electronic Systems, French, Fire Prevention Inspector, Fire Technology, Medical Assisting, Numeric Control, Photography, and Theater Arts.
