Chabot College AA/AS Degrees Awarded 1998-99 to 2013-14 New Transfer Degrees Contribute to Increase in Degrees Awarded


In 2013-14, the number of AA/AS degrees awarded at Chabot surged to 836, the highest in sixteen years and an increase of 125 degrees over the previous year.

Half of the increase came from graduates in eleven new transfer degrees. The Liberal Arts and Biology-Allied Health majors contributed the next biggest increases. Among all other degree majors, the number of graduates increased in some areas and decreased in others, with a net loss of 2l graduates in these areas.

The new transfer degrees allow students to graduate with a degree and meet transfer requirements as well.
