"Increase the number of students that achieve their educational goal within a reasonable time."

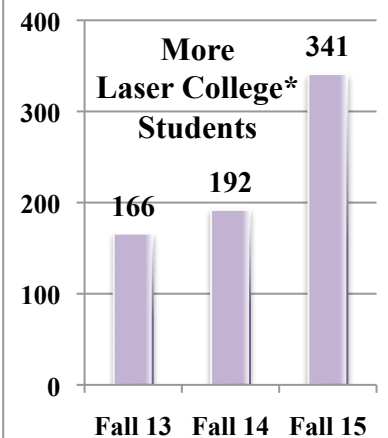
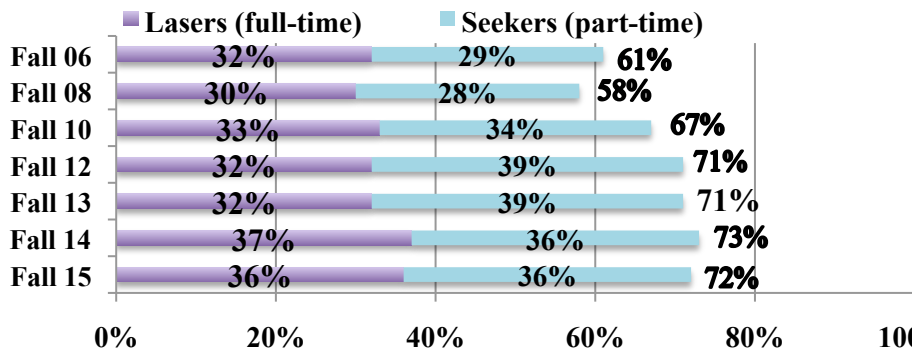
Have we made any progress since 2012? YES! Increases in percentages now = increases in numbers later.

New students in Fall 2013, 2014, & 2015 with transfer or degree goals were more likely than past cohorts to:

- Attend full-time
- Attend as "Laser Full-time College" students, our most successful educational goal group*
- Complete Basic Skills English by the end of their first year
- Complete College English by the end of their first year
- Take a Math course in their first year (of those attending full-time)
- Complete College Math by the end of their first year (of those attending full-time)

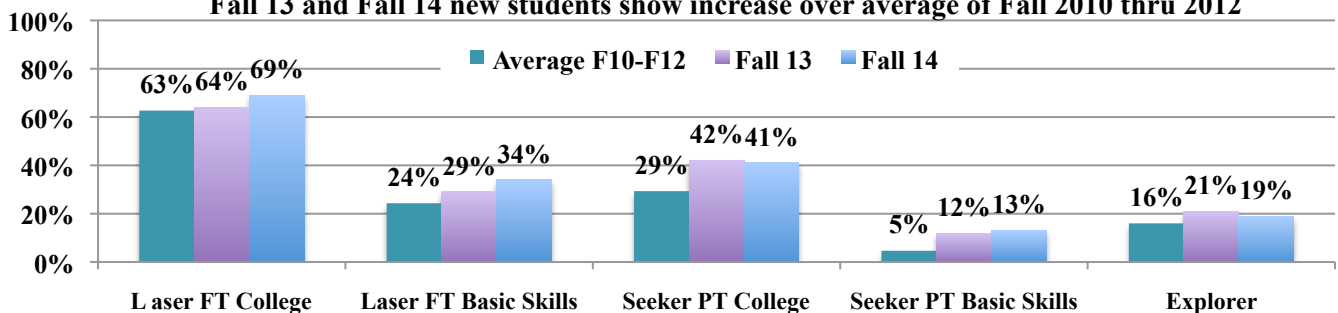
The college initiatives that encourage more students to attend full-time and complete milestones are paying off! As more students complete these milestones than previous cohorts, more are likely to achieve their educational goals.

among New Students with Transfer or Degree Goals**



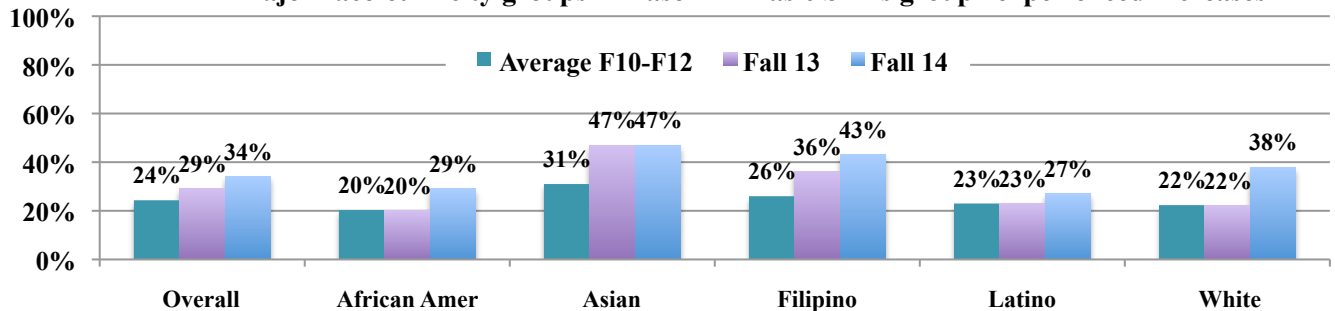
Milestone by end of First Year: Completed College English
