Summary of Progress on Milestones after Four Years of Initiatives

Our Strategic Plan goal since 2012 has been:

"Increase the number of students that achieve their educational goal within a reasonable time."

In 2016, we added, "and ensure equitable outcomes among student groups."

Have we made any progress? YES! Increases in percentages now = increases in numbers later.

New students in Fall 2015, 2016, & 2017 with transfer or degree goals were more likely than past cohorts to:

- Attend full-time
- Attend as "Laser Full-time College" students, our most successful educational goal group*

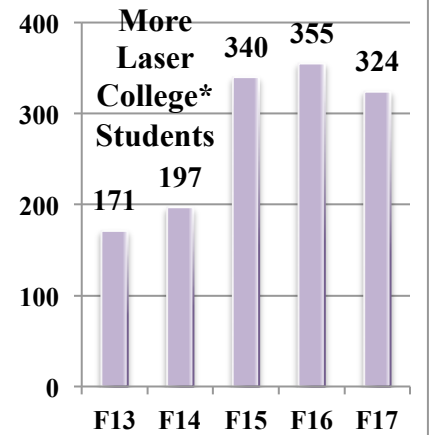
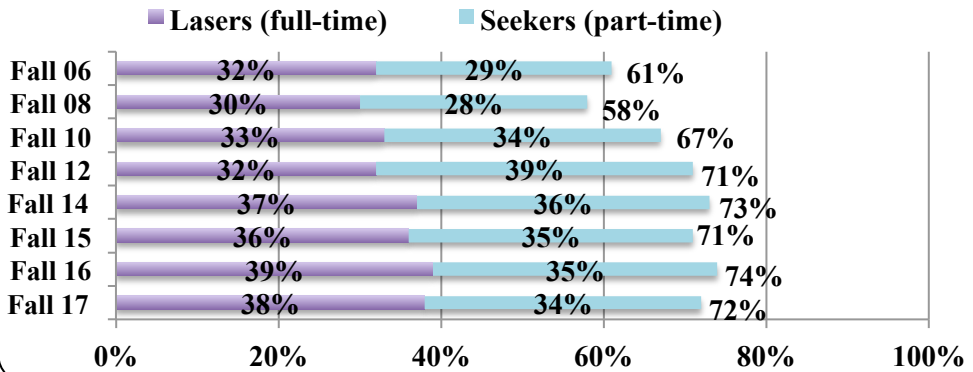
Students in Fall 2015 & 2016 cohorts were more likely to:

- Complete College English by the end of their first year
- Complete a Math course in their first year

The college initiatives that encourage more students to attend full-time and complete milestones are paying off!

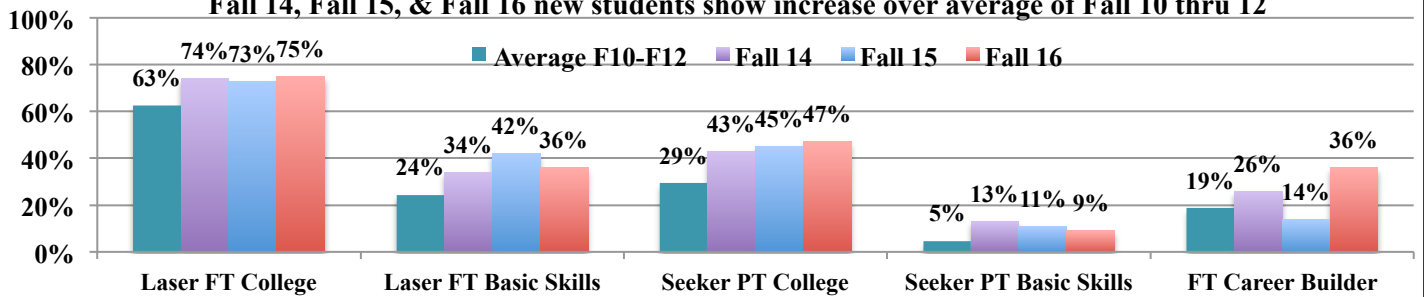
As more students complete these milestones than previous cohorts, more are likely to achieve their educational goals.

Higher Percentages of Full-time Students among New Students with Transfer/Degree Goals



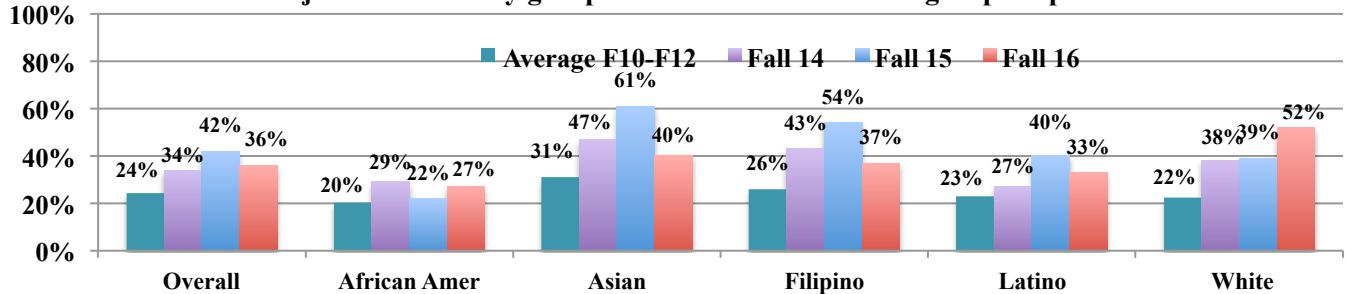
Milestone by the end of First Year: Completed College English
