## Summary of Progress after Three Years of Initiatives

Our Strategic Plan goal since 2012 has been:

*"Increase the number of students that achieve their educational goal within a reasonable time."*

New students in Fall 2014, 2015, & 2016 with transfer or degree goals were more likely than past cohorts to:

- Attend full-time
- Attend as "Laser Full-time College" students, our most successful educational goal group\*

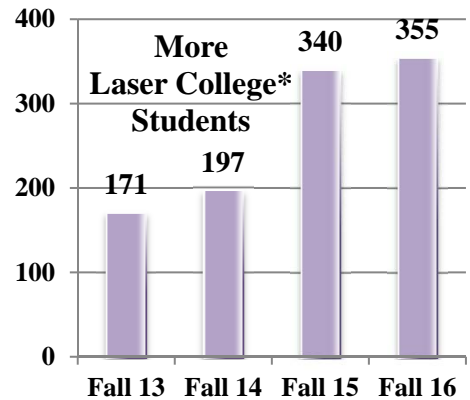
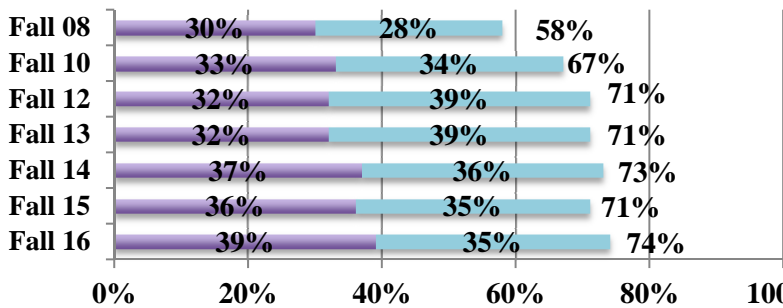
For Fall 2014 & 2015 cohorts:

- Complete College English by the end of their first year
- Take a Math course in their first year
- Complete College Math by the end of their first year

The college initiatives that encourage more students to attend full-time and complete milestones are paying off! As more students complete these milestones than previous cohorts, more are likely to achieve their educational goals.

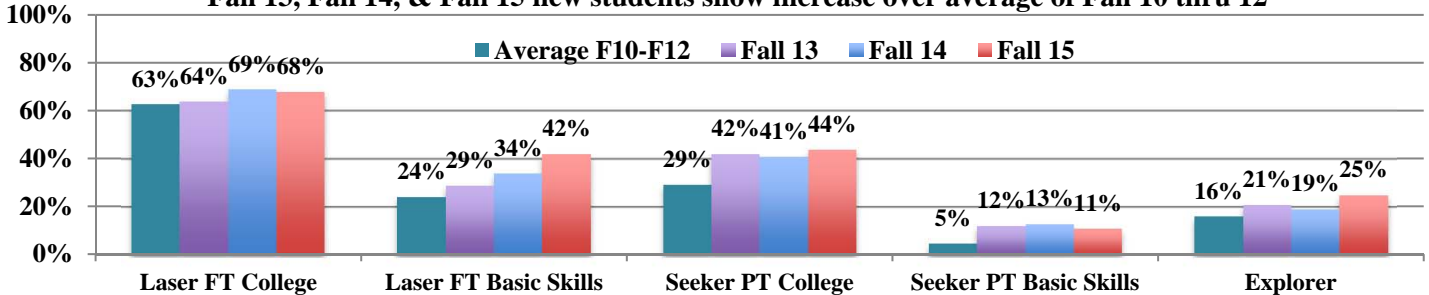
### Higher Percentages of Full-time Students among New Students with Transfer/Degree Goals

■ Lasers (full-time)    ■ Seekers (part-time)



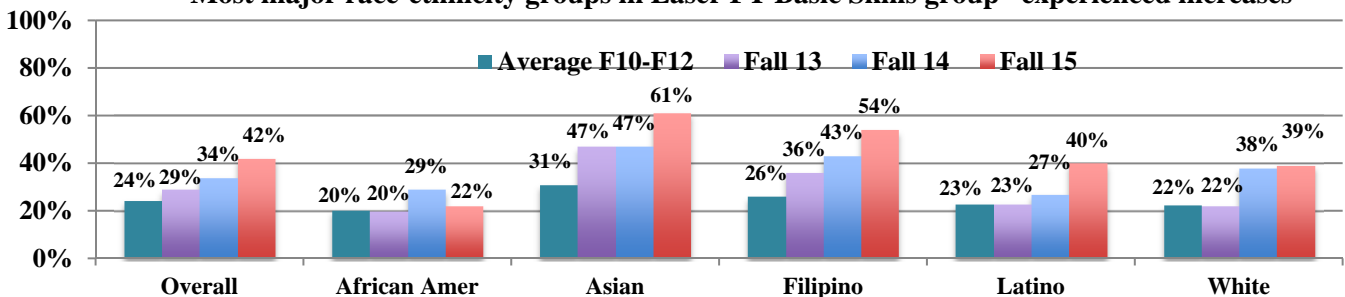
### Milestone by the end of First Year: Completed College English
