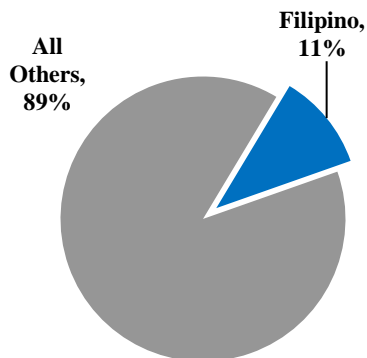


Filipino Students at Chabot College: Success and Persistence

These tables show the latest course success and persistence rates of Filipino students at Chabot by gender, age, student type, and educational goal. Filipino students have similar success and persistence rates when compared to all Chabot students.

Among Filipino students, success rates are highest among students 30 or older, new and continuing students, and students with AA/AS degree and job training goals. Persistence rates are highest among women and men 19 or younger, new male and female students and new students with transfer and AA/AS goals.
