Compared to 5 years ago:


The numbers of transfers, degrees, and certificates are up!


The recent degree increase was shared by most race-ethnicity groups.


However, can we sustain these increases? Degree increases were driven by new AA-T Degrees.

The percentage of students who earn a degree or transfer within 3 years is very low for most groups. Students who are Lasers (FT with transfer/degree goals) and start in College English are most likely to complete. If we place more students into College English, will more complete within 3 years?
