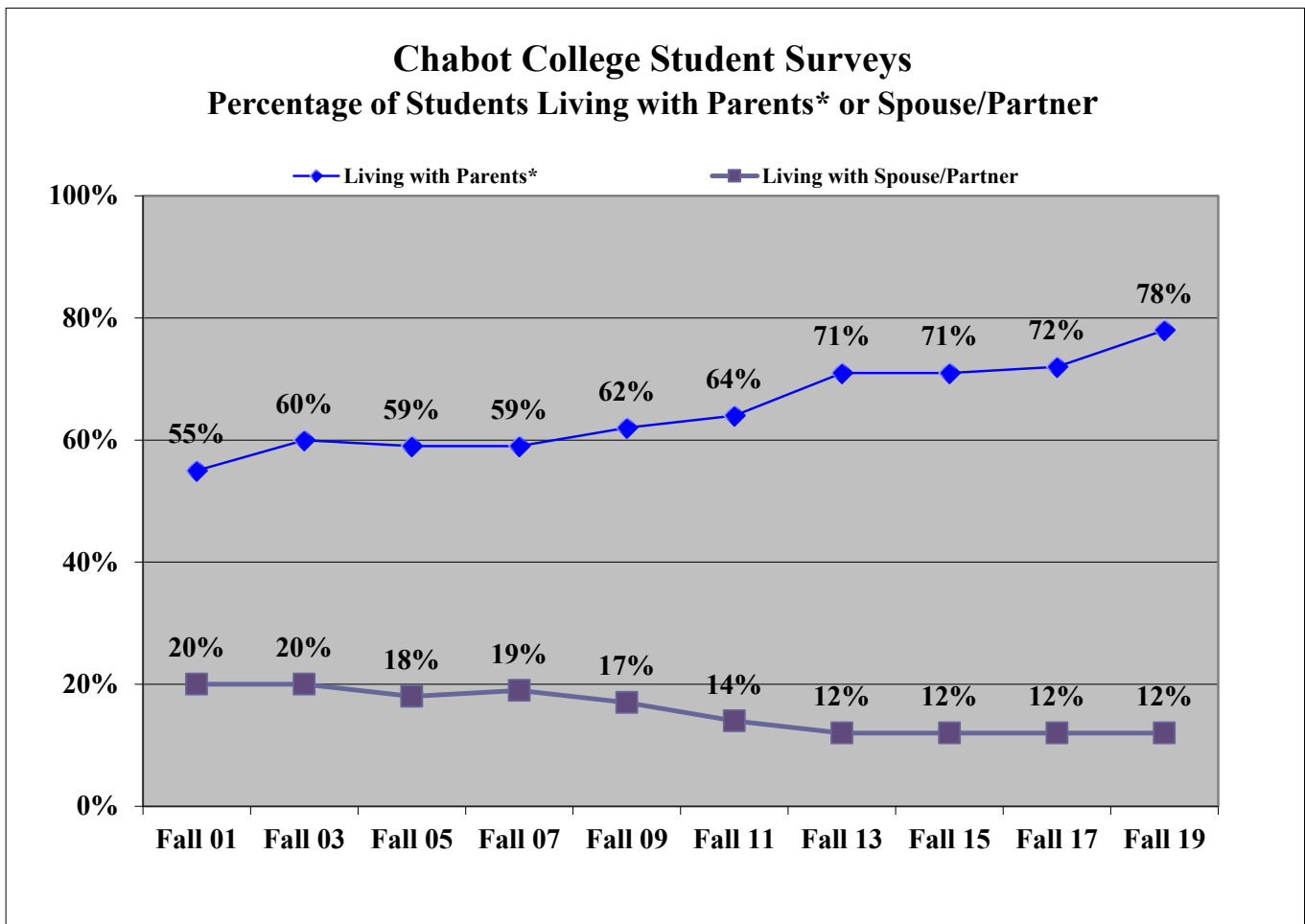

SOURCE NOTES: The Chabot College Student Satisfaction Survey is conducted every other Fall. Surveys are conducted in a representative sample of on-campus course sections. Each percentage has a margin of error of one to three percentage points. In Fall 2019, the survey was completed by 1,544 students (59% full-time, 41% part-time)
