- Build flexible documentation systems that can incorporate both quantitative and qualitative information about student learning.

Attendees felt that even though many instructors put the CLOs in their syllabus, students are not necessarily aware of them. The group felt that putting the CLOs in the College Course Catalog would not be practical. Adina suggested putting the CLOs on each discipline's website.
