Scott Hildreth Selected as NASA Ambassador

Scott Hildreth, Chabot College Instructor of Physics and Astronomy is one of 30 teachers from 10 states selected as a 2021 NASA Airborne Astronomy Ambassador (AAA). AAA is a professional development program for science teachers designed to improve science teaching and increase student learning and STEM engagement.

AAA teachers receive training in astrophysics and planetary science. Scott will participate in a week-long STEM immersion experience at a NASA astronomy research facility such as the <u>Stratospheric Observatory for Infrared Astronomy</u> (SOFIA), a Boeing 747SP aircraft modified to carry a 106-inch reflecting telescope. After training, as an AAA, Scott will teach a physical science curriculum module created by the SETI Institute that connects curriculum concepts to NASA and SOFIA-enabled research.

About the Airborne Astronomy Ambassadors program: The SETI Institute's NASA Airborne Astronomy Ambassadors (AAA) program is one of 30 awards to U.S. organizations competitively selected by NASA under the Science Activation program. Selections are made by the agency's Science Mission Directorate (SMD) in Washington, DC.

About the SETI Institute: Founded in 1984, the SETI Institute is a non-profit, multi-disciplinary research and education organization whose mission is to explore, understand, and explain the origin and nature of life in the universe and the evolution of intelligence. The SETI Institute is a distinguished research partner for industry, academia and government agencies, including NASA and NSF.

Early Childhood Development (ECD) Major Accomplishments By Alice Hale and Hilal Ozdemir

- Chabot College is proud to include our Early Childhood Development (ECD) Program in the Major Accomplishments section of the ISER. We are excited to highlight the following achievements:
- The ECD program has several stackable certificates and degrees which help students earn higher level certificates and eligibility for the state issued ECD permits-similar to Teaching Credential.
- Chabot ECD students earn the most certificates because of stackable certificates.
- Our ECD degrees and basic certificates (teacher) align with most of the ECD programs at other community colleges, so students can have a seamless transition (CAP aligned-Curriculum Alignment Project) from one college to another.

- The ECD program has a system that guides students as they move up the career ladder—guiding them through the permit (Associate Teacher to Center Director).
- The ECD program received National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC) accreditation two years ago, and was one of the few colleges in California to do so.
- We have a 20-year-old program of a cohort for students who are Spanish language speakers. Over two years they take the four classes required for the licensing of preschool teachers. We are currently trying different strategies to encourage those students to continue to take classes, even shepherding one group through additional ECD and general education classes to qualify for a higher level child development permit. This has been difficult to sustain, especially under the pandemic, so we are encouraging students to cohort themselves and offering a sequence of classes that we think make sense for them to further their education.


