

Chabot College Faculty/Staff Accreditation Survey: Spring 2014

Highlights

Support for Student Learning at Chabot

There is a very strong commitment to and support for student learning at Chabot, according to the 2014 staff survey. The Faculty/Staff Accreditation Survey was sent to all Chabot staff in March 2014. The overall response rate was 64 percent, with 76 percent of full-time faculty, 83 percent of full-time classified professionals, and 86 percent of administrators represented. Almost half of part-time faculty responded.
